### **What Does the Process Look Like?**

Once all information is gathered your will and/or other documents will be drafted. Once drafted they will be sent to you for a review. Once any changes are made your documents will be finalized. ### **Other Documents You May Consider in Addition to a Will:**

In addition to a will there are a few other documents you should consider having drafted. Power of Attorney: Lets you choose someone to make decisions for you if you become injured or sick. There are two types; one for finances and one for health.

Health Care Directive (Living Will): Let's you choose the end-of-life medical procedures you do not wish to have if you become terminally ill or permanently unconscious. You can decide treatments such as feeding tubes, ventilators, and CPR.
